Introduction

The International University Foundation Programme (IUFP) is a one-year full-time pre-degree course, which offers students a fast track alternative to GCE A Levels and an entry route to prestigious Universities for degree courses. The programme is aimed at admitting international students seeking admittance into Universities after one year of study. Students, upon successfully completing the IUFP can progress to degree courses at Universities that have signed Progression Agreements with London College of Business and Law (LCBL) or other universities which recognise the IUFP informally by agreeing to accept students on a case by case basis.

Benefits of IUFP

1. One year pre-degree course that offers an entry route to prestigious Universities for degree courses.
2. Equips students with skills required to ease into degree courses at leading Universities without the need to undertake a two year GCE A Levels course.
3. Progression to a wide range of degree courses, which include Accounting, Advertising, Biological Sciences, Biomedical Sciences, Business Administration, Business Information Systems, Computing, Economics, Engineering, Events Management, Finance, Hospitality Management, Information Technology, International Relations, International Development, Law, Management, Marketing, Media, Nursing, Public Relations, Psychology, Social Sciences, Politics and so on.
4. Option to apply to a prestigious University of choice (See list below)
5. Assistance to secure a place at a prestigious University via IUFP's University Placement Service.
6. Huge financial savings for parents when compared to undertaking a University Foundation course at universities in UK, Canada, Australia or the USA.



Course Structure

The IUFP is an intensive University Foundation Programme and requires students to undertake at least six subjects over a period of one year. All students on the programme will undertake three core compulsory subjects and three electives of their choice, depending on the degree they wish to pursue.

Students will undertake the three compulsory core modules in the first semester (Sept-Dec). Thereafter, they will offer three elective modules in the second semester (Jan-Jun).

These modules will be subject areas relevant to the student's choice of degree.

02 Admissions Criteria

Students must have completed the Secondary/High School education in Nigeria or their own country (for international students) and be at least 16 years old. They must possess Five (5) Credits at WASSCE 'O' Level standard (or it's equivalent), which must include English Language and Mathematics.

IELTS

The Academic English module of the IUFP is designed to improve the English language competence of IUFP students in readiness for their degree studies at University. Students undertaking the IUFP are required to obtain an Overall Band Score of 6.5 (6.0 in each sub-test of Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing) by the time they complete the IUFP if they wish to progress to universities in Australia, Canada, Mauritius or UAE. Otherwise, if they wish to progress to UK universities, their Credit grade in English language in WAEC or NECO is deemed by some (not all) of our university partners in UK as sufficient in meeting the English language criteria. For applicants wishing to progress to University of Hertfordshire or St. Mary's University, Twickenham, London in UK, IELTS is required.

Assessment



The programme is assessed via written examinations (2 hours for Core Subjects and 3 hours for Elective Subjects).

Examinations



Examinations are held twice a year in June and December.

Teaching Methods



Traditional and modern methods, such as lectures, seminars, tutorials, group work, student presentations and internet resourced based learning.

Entrepreneurship Opportunities



Candidates who are enrolled on the IUFP programme have the opportunity of undergoing training in any of our entrepreneurship units at the centre such that they are not only competent but are reckoned with and can operate conveniently and competitively with their counterparts from any part of the world.

Award



On successful completion of the IUFP at Broad Concept, students are awarded the IUFP Completion Certificate on the recommendation of the IUFP Assessment Committee, which reports to the IUFP Academic Advisory Board.

Qualification Benchmark



The elective subjects of the IUFP are benchmarked on the Oxford, Cambridge and RSA (OCR) specifications, which meet the requirements of the Common Criteria (Qualifications and Curriculum Authority) and the Advanced Level Qualification Specific Criteria. The programme is a condensed GCEAS and A2 and designed to be more intensive and wider in scope than the standard GCE A Level course.

Duration



The duration of the IUFP is one year.

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Degree Progression

On completion of the IUFP, successful students may progress to the degree courses listed below at universities that have signed Progression Agreements with LCBL or recognised the IUFP informally by agreeing to accept students on a case-by-case basis, subject to passing the relevant elective subject(s) and availability of openings at the preferred university of the student. Pedigree

The IUFP has been running for over 14 years and as such it is well developed.

For example, it already has the following:

- a) Recognition by universities in Australia, Canada, Mauritius, UAE and UK.
- b) Fully developed Curriculum (comprehensively updated in 2022).
- c) Operations Guidelines for candidates.
- d) Examination Guidelines for candidates.
- e) Consistent history of UK university admissions for IUFP students.
- f) IUFP candidates enrolled at any of IUFP partner schools (e.g Broad Concept) have the privilege of one year (the training year) to grow and mature in familiar surroundings, as against going to the UK, UAE, Canada, Australia or Mauritius when they are still relatively immature.

Examination Centres

IUFP currently follows the Oxford, Cambridge and RSA (OCR) Examinations' operational model, which means that students can undertake examinations within the premises of a partner school (Broad Concept International and Entrepreneurship Hub), but with Invigilators appointed by IUFP Global Education being able to visit and oversee the conduct of the examination unannounced and produce a report.

Annual Review

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is IUFP?

The International University Foundation Programme (IUFP) is a one-year full-time pre-degree course, which offers students an alternative entry route to leading universities in 5 continents (Africa, Australia, Middle- East, North- America and Europe) for degree courses.

The programme is aimed at admitting international students, including those based in the United Kingdom seeking direct admittance to leading Universities without the need to undertake a two-year GCE 'A 'level course.

How long does the course last?

The IUFP is designed to be completed for one academic year (9 months) for the Standard Scheme, though students enrolled on the Intensive Scheme can complete the course in six months (usually between January and June).

Broad Concept International (for now) runs the IUFP standard scheme which is built to run from September to June.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What are the admissions criteria?

Prospective IUFP students must have completed Secondary or High School. They must possess 5 Credits at WASSCE (or its equivalent) which must include English Language and Mathematics. IUFP students must be at least 16 years old, though applicants desiring to progress to the University of Greenwich must be at least 15 years old at the start of the IUFP course at a Partner School.

When is the next admission?

Admission for IUFP students in Broad Concept International runs from August to September every year. Late entries can still be allowed till Mid - September.

What courses can be studied upon completing the IUFP Programme?

IUFP provides a pathway for students progressing to degree courses in Accounting, Biological Sciences, Biomedical Sciences, Business, Business Information Systems, Computing, Economics, Engineering, Events Management, Finance, Hospitality Management, Information Technology, International Development, Management, Marketing, Nursing, and so on.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

When will classes start?

Classes start in September (this is for core subjects). Students will take three compulsory/core subjects and write examinations for the core subjects in December.

While classes start for elective courses (a student is required to select three elective subjects out of twelve) in January and end in June, the examination for elective subjects takes place in early July.

Where are the examinations held?

For IUFP students studying at Broad Concept International and Entrepreneurship Hub, examinations take place within our premises. Though examination scripts are marked by IUFP examiners and moderated in the United Kingdom by Academics and Subject Convenors retained by the London College of Business and Law.

When will the results for the core subjects be out?

The results of the core subjects will be out by January.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

When will the results of the elective subjects be out?

The results of the elective subjects will be out by early August.

Are books provided as part of the course materials?

Bespoke E-books for the IUFP curriculum are provided via the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) on the IUFP Portal. Hence, students and parents are not required to buy books.

Do I need IELTS as part of the course?

If you are planning to progress to a university in Australia, Canada, Mauritius or UAE, you are required to undertake the IELTS course and obtain an overall band score of 6.5, as it is one of the admission requirements for universities in those countries. For applicants wishing to progress to University of Hertfordshire or St. Mary's University, Twickenham, London in UK, IELTS is required.

Which Universities can I gain admission to upon my completion of IUFP?

Our successful candidates can gain admission into Universities in Australia, Canada, Mauritius, United Arab Emirates and The United Kingdom.

Is Accommodation Available?

IELTS

The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is an English language test that is used for educational, immigration, and occupational purposes. It is accepted by over 10,000 institutions across 140 countries; Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, some Asian countries, and Australia just to mention a few.

SAT

Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) is one of the most important tests for anyone looking to gain a scholarship or study at American universities (US/Canada). It is controversially the equivalent of JAMB in Nigeria with almost every American university making it an admission requirement.

TOEFL

The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) test seeks to test one's ability to communicate in English, specifically in academics; university, and classroom-based settings. It is accepted by over 8,500 institutions across 130 countries, including the UK, USA, and Australia.
